## Designer/Artist Notes

At MākerCulture we have two artist/designers who work with recycled silver.

**Victoria** creates beautiful minimal style jewellery inspired by nature, and handmade using recycled sterling silver and brass. She experiments with shapes and texture, designing jewellery that creates the least amount of waste.

“I collect hydrangea petals in the winter when they have turned to skeletons and once dry, I put them through a rolling mill with the recycled sterling silver or brass which imprints the delicate pattern into the metal. ”

Her extensive range of different designs includes earrings, rings, necklaces and bracelets - delicate and dainty, perfect for everyday.

Victoria lives in Wiltshire.

**Elaine** has a background in fine art, working mostly with photography and printmaking before discovering how much she enjoyed combining these skills with jewellery design. Her jewellery is the result of a love of beautiful patterns and texture, a keen interest in design, and the possibilities of materials. She uses traditional techniques and new technology to create jewellery with organic textures for lovers of wearable design.

Her jewellery is made from eco silver with sterling silver findings.
